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AUTOMATIC METER TECHNOLOGY OPT-OUT FORM

Reason for Opt-Out:

The District reads its electric meters both manually (read by District personnel) and automatically. Automatic meters transmit reads electronically to the District's billing system. By District policy a customer has the right to decline use (opt-out) of an automatic meter on their premise.

Once a customer opts-out of the Automatic Meter Technology program, a monthly fee (currently \$25) will be assessed to cover the cost of sending District personnel to manually read the meter. Installation of a manually read meter, in place of an existing automatic meter, will require a one-time Automatic Meter Technology Opt-Out Fee (currently \$165) due upon submission of this form. The one-time fee is not required if the customer opts-out prior to the installation of the automatic meter.

As a condition of receiving electric service, the District, through its authorized employees, shall be granted all necessary rights-of-way and easements over the property of the customer, and have the right of access to customer's premises as reasonably required for the purpose of reading meters, testing, inspecting, maintaining, installing, or removing any District equipment located thereon. At no time is the owner/tenant/account holder authorized to remove, adjust, or tamper with PUD equipment. In no circumstances is a residential meter allowed within any enclosure or premise.

If meter access is not available on a 24/7 basis allowing District personnel availability to PUD equipment, opt-out requests may be denied or rescinded, and an automatic meter will be installed. The account holder will be responsible for any related fees and will still be required to provide access to the meter and any other District facilities located on the customer's premise.

The District will return the service to an automatic meter at the time the service transfers to a different customer unless the new customer completes the opt-out request form at the time of application of service.

By signing this form the customer is indicating they would like to opt-out of Pacific County PUD's Automatic Meter Technology program.
