### **Board of Commissioners promotes Marc Wilson to GM position**

The Pacific County PUD Board of Commissioners announced the appointment of Marc Wilson to serve as the PUD's next General Manager. Wilson, a longtime employee of Pacific County PUD, was appointed unanimously by the board and will assume the duties of General Manager upon the retirement of Jason Dunsmoor in December 2022. Dunsmoor announced his retirement earlier this year after a 30-plus year career with the PUD, including more than five years as General Manager.



Wilson, whose career at the PUD spans nearly three decades, was named General Manager after an extensive competitive search and selection process that included input from both community and staff.

Wilson has held several positions with Pacific County PUD including Energy Intern, Energy Analyst, Utility Engineer-Energy Analyst, IT Admin, IT Director and most recently IT Manager. Wilson says he is looking forward to continuing to serve the customers of Pacific County PUD as General Manager. "I am grateful for the opportunity the Commissioners have given me. I look forward to working together with them to maintain the District's successful direction." Wilson will be working with Jason Dunsmoor for the remainder of the year to ensure a smooth transition.

### **Supply chain issues affecting PUD**

As is the case with many other PUDs and businesses alike, the District is seeing lead times up to two and a half years and prices abnormally high for materials compared to recent years. Due to this and the demand in Pacific County, the engineering department will be letting customers whose job requires a new transformer know that service may not be available when they are ready to be connected. Customers can have their fees refunded or be put on a waiting list to be connected on a first come, first serve basis. For those planning on building or applying for a new service, it is recommended that you get your application in early in the process and be sure you have met all requirements from the District and received an approved L & I inspection. The District is doing all they can to temporarily relieve this issue with limited success. Hopefully the situation will improve soon.

## Energy Services funds available



The District is informing customers that there are \$350,000 in the Energy Services budget to be expended before September 30, 2023, on energy efficiency measures. This includes adding insulation, window replacements, new heat pumps (ducted or ductless), manufactured homes, and heat pump water heaters. Customers must submit an Energy Efficiency Program Agreement and have an audit by the District completed prior to installation to receive approval. Low income customers can also apply for an increased rebate amount. All rebate amounts are subject to change and cannot exceed the cost of the approved measure.
