## **RESOLUTION NO. 1442**

## A RESOLUTION REVISING THE EXISTING RATES AND CHARGES FOR CODE BOOK SECTION 6.34.160 – AREA LIGHTING AND SECTION 6.34.161 – STREET LIGHTING

WHEREAS, Public Utility District No. 2 of Pacific County offers street and area lighting to interested customers under Section 6.34.160 – Area Lighting and Section 6.34.161 – Street Lighting of the District's Code Book; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No. 2 of Pacific County, Washington adopted the current Street and Area Lighting Rates under Resolution No. 1387 on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017; and

WHEREAS, under Schedules 160 and 161, the District makes available on a monthly rental basis area and street lighting utilizing rates for various sizes LED fixtures; and

WHEREAS, the actual cost of lighting fixtures, energy usage, labor, and poles in which the rates are based have increased; and

WHEREAS, the rates adopted shall reflect the increase in actual cost incurred by the District for providing and maintaining the lights; and

WHEREAS, based on the points described above, it is the opinion of the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No. 2 of Pacific County, Washington, that the present rate schedules for Area Lighting and Street Lighting should, in the best interests of the District, be revised.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the attached revised rate schedules for Area Lighting and Street Lighting be adopted as part of the electric rates of P.U.D. No. 2 of Pacific County, effective November 1, 2021. The rate schedules to be revised are attached hereto, and by the following reference are made a part hereof:
