

RESOLUTION NO. 1460

**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING THE DECLARATION
OF EMERGENCY UNDER RCW 39.04.280**

WHEREAS, on February 29, 2020, Governor Jay Inslee declared Washington State to be in a state of emergency due to the existence of a novel coronavirus or COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the outbreak of COVID-19 was an event unprecedented in the existence of PUD No. 2 of Pacific County; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1428 was adopted on March 23, 2020 declaring an emergency under RCW 39.04.280; and


WHEREAS, the District adopted policy in response to the event that will be applicable if another such event may occur; and

WHEREAS, Governor Jay Inslee announced on September 8, 2022 that he will terminate the statewide COVID-19 state of emergency on October 31, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state of emergency declared by the General Manager be rescinded in conjunction with the State of Washington on October 31, 2022; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all previous resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
