Spring 2021


In October of 2019, the District raised rates after being affected by an increase in power costs from Bonneville Power Administration (BPA). After this, and through March 2021, the District was able to use \$525,000 of reserve funds to postpone another retail rate increase by covering the ever-growing costs of purchasing electricity from BPA and maintaining the electric system. Living in beautiful Pacific County comes with strong winds and the coastal environment, including the harsh salt air with its corrosive effects. The District works hard to provide the most reliable service with over 70% of the system underground and the investment of stainless steel and bronze materials which stand up to the conditions and the test of time, though the cost may be more than seen by other utilities.

Another increase in the cost of purchasing power from BPA is anticipated in the Fall of 2021. Historically, this would result in a retail rate increase effective at the same time. This year the District will evaluate the BPA increase through the

winter months rather than apply the increase, lessening the burden of higher winter bills, and if deemed necessary will consider an increase for next spring. After careful consideration from the Board of Commissioners, Resolution No. 1437 was passed on March 16, 2021 increasing rates as shown. The rates in the table will be effective April 1, 2021.
